#### Facts for Joseph Smith, Jr.

Visited by the angel Moroni on September 1823 and directed to the gold plates containing the history of the people who left them in 421 A.D.<sup>4750</sup>. Organized the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints on April 6, 1830<sup>4751</sup>. First President and Prophet of the Mormon Church<sup>4752</sup>. Ran for President of the US against James K. Polk and Henry Clay<sup>4753</sup>. Believed to have had between 27 and 49 wives<sup>4754</sup>. Names of 28 wives shown<sup>4755</sup>. Warning: wives are not listed in the correct order<sup>4756</sup>.

#### Facts for Brigham Young

Mormon leader<sup>4757</sup>. 9th of 11 children<sup>4758</sup>. House painter and carpenter from Whitingham, VT<sup>4759</sup>. Elected second president of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in about December 1844<sup>4760</sup>. Appointed first governor of the UT Territory by President Millard Fillmore in 1850<sup>4761</sup>. Announced on August 29, 1852 that the
