The limousine that followed them had black tinted windows, it was close behind as they drove into a double lane and stopped at a red light. The limo pulled up right beside them.

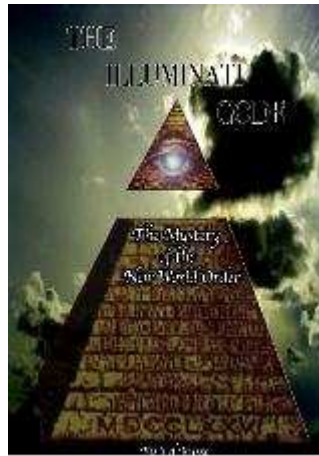
Clarence said to Alfred, "I don't think these men have any grey poupon."
